Brief:

Background: UIA aims to develop progressive ideas in the fields of architecture, town planning, and the built environment....

UIA Work Programme Heritage and Cultural Identity (hereafter *WP Heritage*) is dedicated to the architectural design intervention aspects of the heritage sites and vicinity in the urban context. Its main aim is to promote the contribution of architectural design intervention, conservation and restoration of heritage buildings, so that a full understanding of urban landscape and morphology become an intrinsic part of conservation practice. *WP Heritage* aims also at establishing, and regularly updating, guidelines or recommendations for the architectural design intervention and to disseminate the knowledge and experience acquired at the international level.

WP Heritage combines with “Spiritual Places” and “Sustainable Tourism.”

Plans for the 2017-2020 Triennium

Goals

1. To promote continuity and integrity: proper design intervention considering UN SDG
2. To contribute to the governance: conservation of heritages while developing the neighbourhood
3. To raise public awareness: architect’s role in the urban context and conservation of historic sites
4. To share the knowledge: advanced approach to maintaining the quality of the cultural landscape and sustainable tourism

Activities

1. Continuation with issues of regional activities such as: energy efficiency of historic buildings in Europe (Region I & II); join the European Heritage Alliance 3.3 network (Region I); an index and map of architectural heritage in the America (Region III); Dark heritage such as ‘on the conservation of leprosy colony’ (Region IV); Future Heritage (Region V) and so on..
